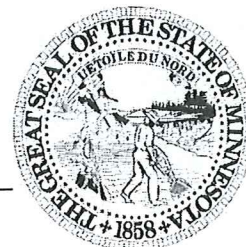

**Nature of Complaint**

Candidate for City of Grant Mayor in November of 2016 Ms. Shannon Bryant established a Go Fund Me page to raise money for her candidacy.

In the course of raising \$2,000 dollars Ms. Shannon accepted six anonymous donations over \$20.00.

Amounts of individual donations as follows: \$1,300, \$200, \$200, \$100, \$75 and \$50. These amounts should have been remanded to the CFB immediately

These funds have not been disclosed on any financial statements received by the relevant authorities neither has any statement claiming personal protection of the donors been filed to my knowledge. Ms. Bryant spent well over double any opposing candidate and seems to have done so with anonymous funding. The difficulty of screen-printing the relevant pages hopefully will be forgiven, as it is clearly discernable the \$2,000 Mayoral fundraising campaign met its goal and the donations were largely anonymous.

Ms. Bryant seems to have violated 10A.105 and 10A.15 and perhaps Federal campaign law pertaining to anonymous donations and disclosures. I would hope the CFPDB will issue subpoenas sufficient to establish the Go Fund Me end of funding campaign transfer to Ms. Bryant's account (s)

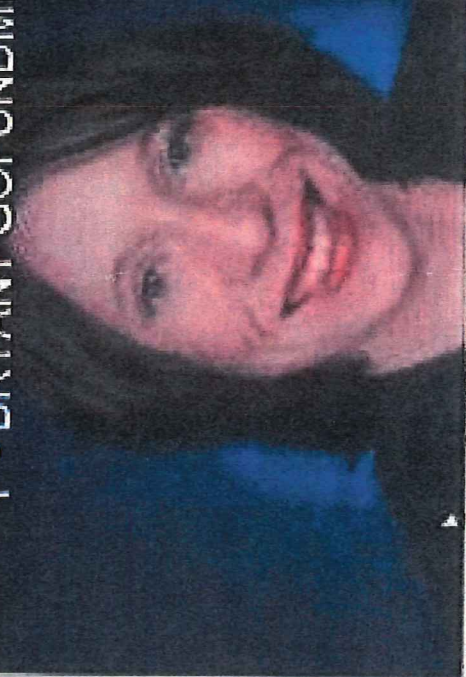
