Payment Plan

At its May 1, 2019, meeting, the Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board authorized the executive director to enter into an agreement with Doug Wardlow that provides for payment of a \$46,417.53 civil penalty imposed on the Doug Wardlow for Attorney General committee for exceeding the committee's spending limit for the 2017-2018 election segment. The civil penalty was imposed pursuant to a conciliation agreement approved by the Board at the same meeting. The terms of the payment plan are set forth below.

The committee will forward to the Board by June 3, 2019, a signed copy of the conciliation agreement and an initial payment of \$10,000.

The remaining balance of \$36,417.53 will be paid in four installments that are due on October 1, 2019; April 1, 2020; October 1, 2020; and April 1, 2021. There is no minimum payment due for each installment, but the full remaining balance is due no later than April 1, 2021. Doug Wardlow and the Wardlow committee are free to increase the frequency of payments at any time without any prepayment penalty.

If the full remaining balance owed is not paid by April 1, 2021, then the full remaining balance owed will be due immediately and the Board may take any action necessary to collect the unpaid amount.

The Board agrees to charge no interest on the outstanding balance during the period of the payment plan. All payments must be made by check or money order made payable to the State of Minnesota.
